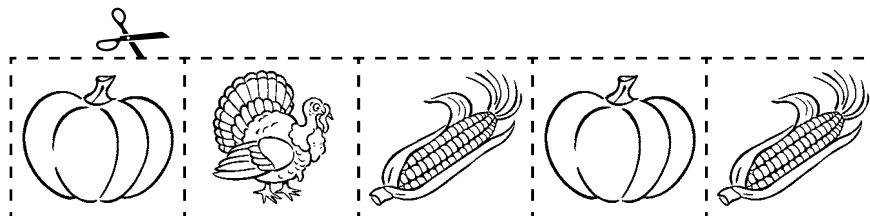
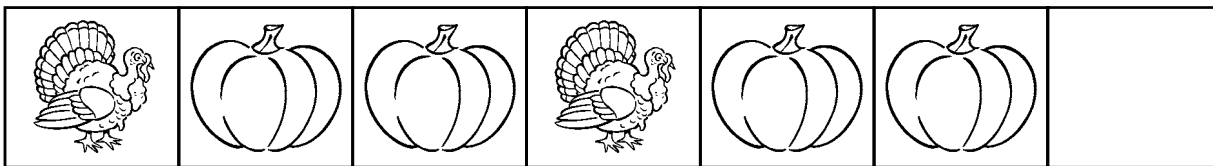
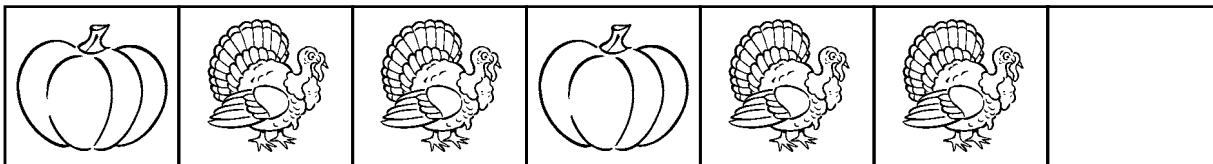
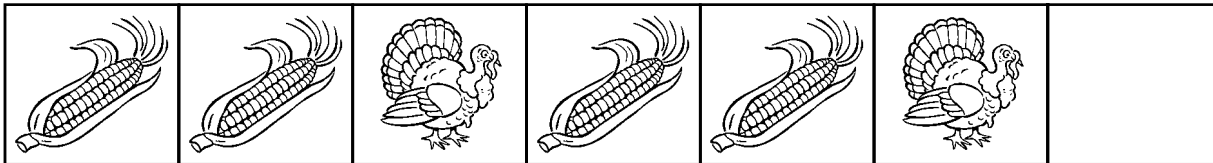
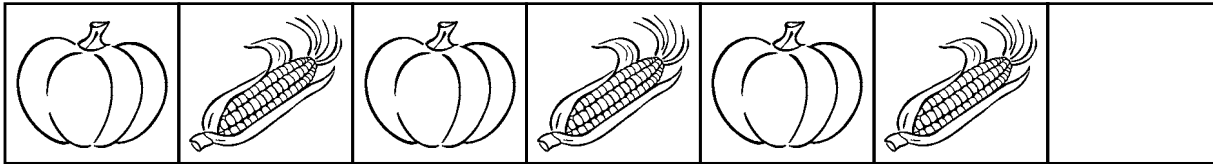
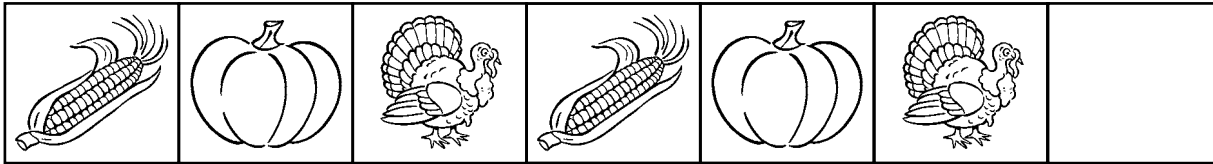
THANKFUL TIMES • FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS
