2B Who am I?

You will need: one worksheet per student.

- Before giving out the worksheets, write a number in the box at the top. If you have ten students, for example, write 1 to 10.
- Distribute the worksheets in random order. Students
 work individually. They must not write their name on the
 paper, and are not allowed to look at their classmates'
 papers. They should try to begin each sentence with a
 gerund, or another phrase used to describe general/
 abstract ideas (see page 24 of the Students' Book).
- Collect the worksheets, shuffle them and put them up around the classroom.
- Students work individually or in pairs. They walk around the class and read the worksheets, then decide which student wrote each.
- · The student or pair with the most correct guesses wins.
