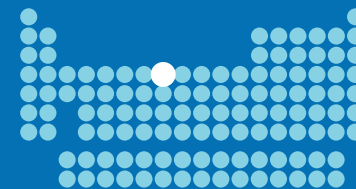
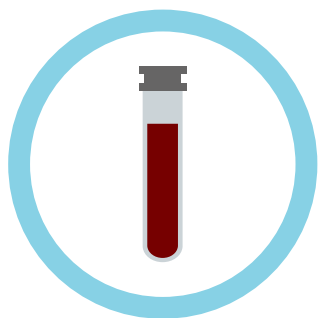

BLOOD



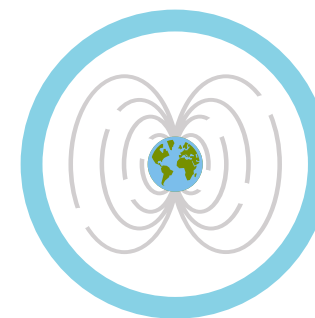
Blood's red colour is from the iron in haemoglobin, which helps carry oxygen from the lungs to cells.
