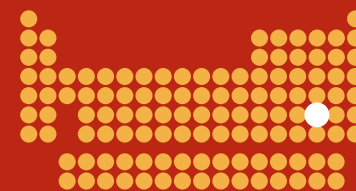

### TOXIC



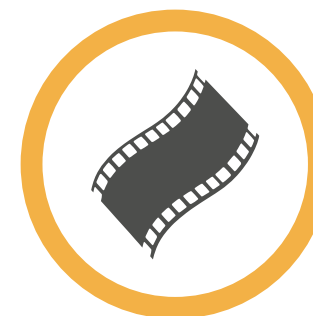
Named after Poland by its discoverer, Marie Curie. Polonium is toxic if ingested, even in small amounts.

### HEAT SOURCE



Polonium is so intensely radioactive it has been used as a heat source in moon rovers and satellites.

### ANTI-STATIC



Small amounts of Po-210 are found in anti-static brushes, which remove dust from photographic film.
