

# Questions?



Hello and welcome back. In this lesson we will be looking at **questions**.

A **question** is a sentence which asks for some information, an **answer** is the reply.

A sentence that is a question ends with the symbol – (?).

# Who?

The word **who** is used to find out the person of interest.  
Therefore '**who**' is only used when referring to people.



# Examples:

Who is this?



Who ate the cake?



Who has money?



Who has red hair?



# Where?

The word **where** is used to find out a place.

Therefore '**where**' is only used when referring to a place or location.



# Examples:

Where are you?



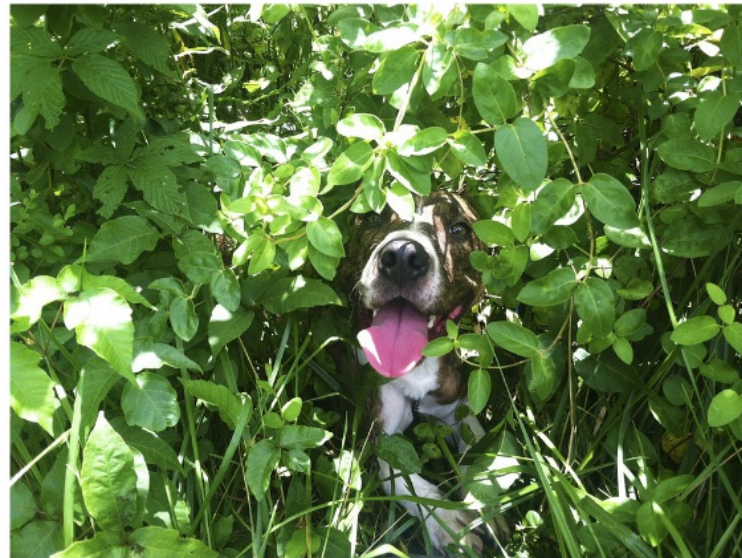
Where is the bus?



Where is the money?



**Where is the dog?**



# When?

The word **when** is used to find out the time.

Therefore '**when**' is only used when referring to a time or an occasion.





# Examples:

When shall we meet?



When is my birthday?



When are we on holiday?



**When do we go?**



# Why?

The word **why** is used to find out the reason for something.  
Therefore '**why**' is only used when referring to an explanation or a reason.



## Examples:

Why are you late?



Why am I paying?



Why are you here?



The reply/answer will start with "**Because...**"

**Why are you angry?**



# What?

The word **what** is used to find out something.

Therefore '**what**' is only used when referring to specific information.



## Examples:

What is the time?



What is your name?



What is your address?



**What is in the box?**





# Which?

The word **which** is used to find out information between two or more subjects.  
Therefore '**which**' is only used when referring to a choice.



# Examples:

Which do you like?



Which shoes?



Which day?

Sunday	Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday	Saturday

**Which hat is red?**



# How?

The word **how** is used to find out the way something is done.  
Therefore '**how**' is used when asking for directions.



# Examples:

How do you cook?



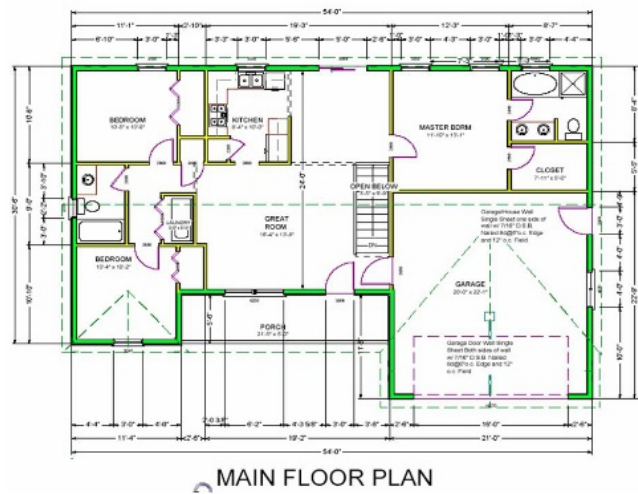
How do you speak English?

# How can I build a house?



## How can be used in other questions:

**How much** is used for a quantity or a price and only with uncountable nouns.

How much is this?    How much time do we have?    How much food?



# How many is used for a quantity but only with countable nouns.

How many apples?



How many days in a week?



How many cars?



How many people?





**How often** is used for a frequency of something.

How often do you eat?



How often do you drive?



How often shall we meet?



**How far** is used for a distance of something.

How far did you drive?



How far are we in the year?
