

Everyday Objects

Hello and welcome back, in this lesson we will be learning some basic vocabulary of everyday objects.

Objects

What is an object?

An object is something or someone that has a name and can be used or has a purpose.

Objects therefore are **nouns**.



What are **nouns**?

Nouns are words that are the names of people or objects. These can be singular or plural.

For most nouns if they are plural an extra 'S' at the end of the noun is needed.

Singular -	Plural
Noun -	Noun+(s)

Examples:

Hat – Hats



Cow – Cows



Boy – Boys



Car – Cars



Book – Books



Nouns that end in ch, x, s, or s sounds
need to have es on the end | plural.

Singular - Plural
Noun(ch) - Noun+(es)
Fox – Foxes



Nouns that end in f or fe swap the
f to a v and add es.

Singular - Plural
Noun (f) - Noun – (f)+(ves)
Scarf – Scarves



Objects need the appropriate articles:

A - Used if the noun starts with a consonant. (singular)
(a computer)



An- used if the noun starts with a vowel. (Singular)
(an apple)



The – used for all nouns if spoken in third person. (Singular)
(the dog)



Objects can be both **Non count nouns**; which can't be counted as they express a group or **Count nouns**, which can be counted as one or more.

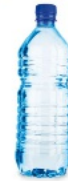
