The face is the front of the head. The head is on the top of your body.

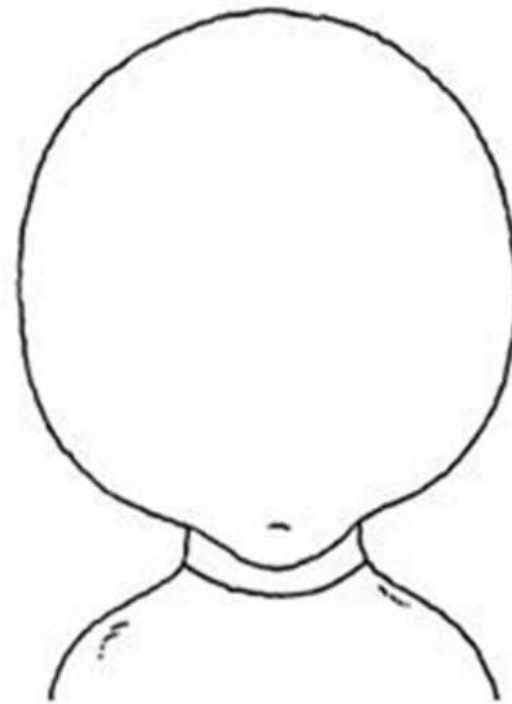
The face has:

3- Eyebrows,

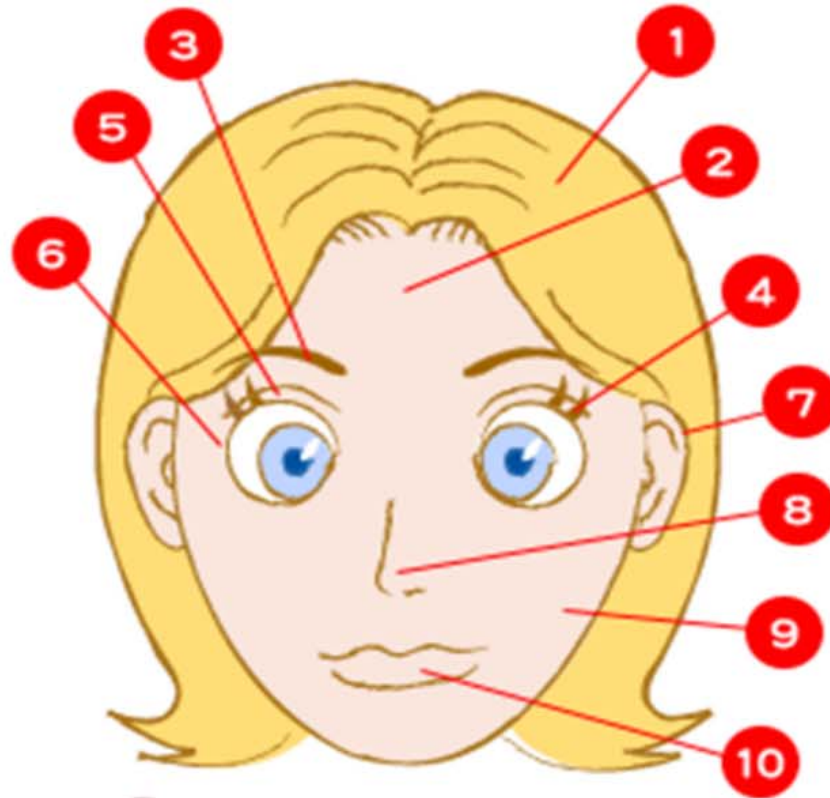
1- Hair,

2- And a forehead.



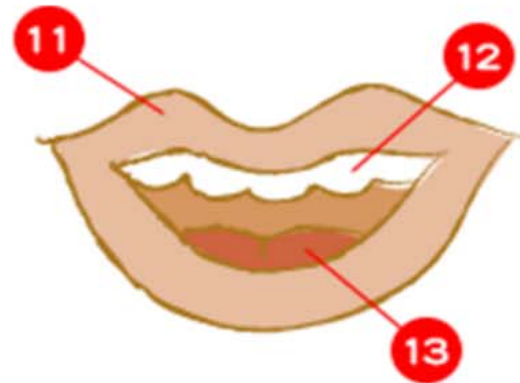
The mouth

The mouth is located on the face but it contains some other features:

12- Teeth,

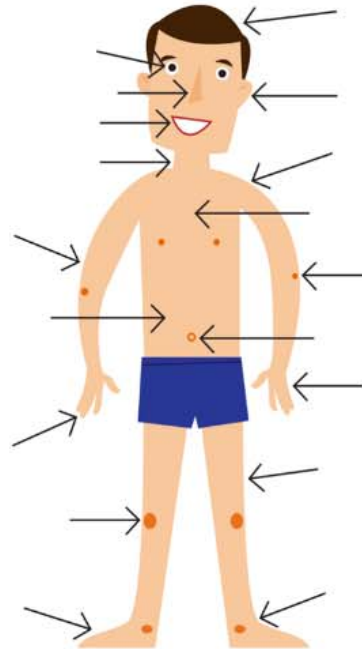
13- Tongue.

Describing the different parts

The body parts are **nouns**, so describe them we need to use **adjectives**.

When describing the **noun** the **adjectives** generally appear immediately before the **noun**.

Colours are used as adjectives, let's take a look at some:



Examples of descriptive words:

A **pretty** girl



Beautiful flowers



Warm soup



A **big** cup of tea



Blue socks



Descriptive words can describe: **size, age, beauty, temperature, origin etc.** basically anyway of describing a person or object.

Describe using colour:



Blue eyes



Red lips



Grey hair

Describe using size:



Long legs



Small nose



Big eyes



Fat tummy

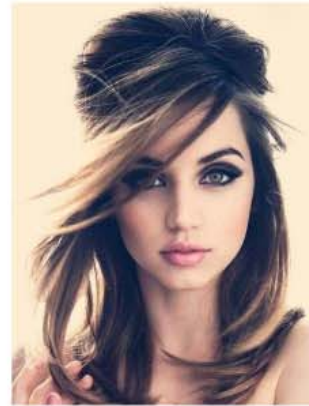
Describing using beauty:

Frozen mouth
