The face is the front of the head. The head is on the top of your body.


The face has:

Ears,


A mouth

- 2- And a forehead.




The mouth





Describing the different parts

The body parts are **nouns**, so describe them we need to use **adjectives**.

When describing the **noun** the **adjectives** generally appear immediately before the **noun**. **Colours** are used as adjectives, let's take a look at some:

Warm soup



A big cup of tea



Blue socks



Descriptive words can describe: size, age, beauty, temperature, origin etc. basically anyway of describing a person or object.

Describe using colour:



Blue eyes



Red lips



Grey hair





Long legs



Small nose



Big eyes



Fat tummy

Describing using beauty:



Pretty eyes



Ugly knees



Nice hair



Bad teeth

Describe using temperature:



Burnt hand



Cold nose



Warm neck




Frozen mouth
